

EU Directives

With reference to the products we have been delivering since the beginning of 2004, we can confirm to you that – referring to our present state of information – the materials we used for the production correspond to the requirements of the following directives

- **2015/863/EU**
- **2000/53/EC**
- **2003/11/EC**

In accordance with our current knowledge, the used materials do not contain any ingredients for which a duty of declaration exists or which are forbidden above the maximum quantity stated in the directives mentioned above.

We cannot confirm that the articles are completely free from the ingredients mentioned in the directive, as the existence of a contamination with traces of banned substances cannot be excluded.

For the metal parts we cannot get a general confirmation according to these directives from our suppliers because the employment of special additives is necessary for some kinds of plating like electro galvanisation.

We do not analyse the existence of banned substances in the plastic parts. The information given is with reference to the information we get from our suppliers. Due to this, our confirmation is only valid as far as the data of our suppliers are correct.

Absolute certainty can only be reached by very expensive and time-consuming analyses.
